Code Information and Examples

(Summary codes used in monthly and quarterly budget-to-actual reports)

Expenditure Function Summary Codes — An account designation that categorizes a reason or purpose served by a particular expenditure or made possible by a particular receipt

100000 INSTRUCTION

110000 Undifferentiated Curriculum

An instructional situation in which one teacher is responsible for providing instruction in two or more curricular areas to the same group of pupils. Examples include a language arts/social studies core program or a first-grade class where a teacher teaches reading, writing, arithmetic, penmanship, etc. to the same group of pupils.

120000 Regular Curriculum

An instructional setting in which a teacher is responsible for instructing a group of pupils in only one curricular area not required to be reported under vocational, health, special or co-curriculum functions.

130000 Vocational Curriculum

Agriculture education, business education, marketing, health occupations, family & consumer science, technology education, special needs

140000 Physical Curriculum

Instructional activities concerned with health and safety in daily living, physical education, and recreation.

150000 Special Education

Instructional activities for pupils with disabilities and provided by specially qualified personnel as required by an Individual Education Program (IEP) for such pupils.

160000 Co-Curricular Activities

Instructional activities under the guidance and supervision of school staff designed to provide students such experiences as motivation, enjoyment and improvement of skills. Co-curricular activities supplement the regular instructional activities and include such activities as band, chorus, speech and debate, athletics.

170000 Other Special Needs

Culturally/Socially Disadvantaged, Gifted & Talented, Non-Special Education Home Bound

200000 SUPPORT SERVICES

210000 Pupil Services

Direction of pupil services, guidance, health services, psychological services, speech pathology and audiology, occupational and physical therapy, other pupil services

220000 Instructional Staff Services

Direction of improvement of instruction, curriculum development, instructional staff training, library media, special education supervision, athletics supervision & coordination, other instructional staff supervision & coordination, other instructional staff services

230000 General Administration

Activities concerned with establishing and administering district policies. Included here are activities of the school board, district administrator, district-wide community relations administrators, legal counsel, auditors, state and federal relations (including activities associated with grant procurement).

240000 School Building Administration

Activities concerned with directing and managing the operation of a particular school. Included here are activities of the principal, assistant principals and other assistants in the general supervision of school operations, staff evaluation, duty assignment, school records, and coordination of school instructional activities.

250000 Business Administration

Direction of business, fiscal, operations. Included here are daily and seasonal operation activities concerned with sites, buildings, servicing (including routine "preventive maintenance" activities) of equipment and vehicles other than pupil transportation vehicles. Examples of activities included here are: contracted custodial services, lawn and landscaping care, snow removal, incidental building repairs and painting, routine servicing of equipment and vehicles other than pupil transportation, utility costs, school security services including police activities for school functions, direction of maintenance & repairs, site repairs, building repairs, direction of pupil transportation, contracted pupil transportation, internal services - activities concerned with purchasing, warehousing, printing, mail distribution services.

260000 Central Services

Activities of a district-wide nature, other than general administration, which support other instructional and supporting service programs. Included here are recruitment of personnel, data processing, information technology services and training for non-instructional staff.

270000 Insurance & Judgments

Insurance premiums for district liability, property, worker's compensation, unemployment compensation. Also recorded here are costs of insurance consultants and judgments.

280000 Debt Services

Long term capital debt, long term operational debt

290000 Other Support Services

Other retiree payments - Expenditures for post-retirement health benefits when the district is on the pay-as-you-go method for funding benefits. Also, district contributions to a post retirement trust fund in excess of the Annual Required Contribution (ARC) when the district is funding benefits using an actuarial cost method recognized by generally accepted accounting principles.

400000 NON-PROGRAM TRANSACTIONS

410000 Transfers to Another Fund

Permanent transfer of money from one fund to another to pay obligations of the receiving fund

430000 Purchased Instructional Services

General base cost tuition – open enrollment or tuition waiver, also special education contracted instruction or additional/excess cost tuition

490000 Other Non-Program Transactions

Adjustments & refunds such as uncollected tax refunded to municipalities

Expenditure Object Summary Codes — An account designation that categorizes an article or service obtained from a specific expenditure

100 Salaries

Wages paid to district employees

200 Employee Benefits

Retirement contributions to Wisconsin Retirement System, Social Security, life insurance, health insurance, dental insurance, long term disability insurance, credit reimbursements, cash-in-lieu of health insurance

300 Purchased Services

Personal services – support services performed by individuals who are not district employees; property services, utilities, pupil travel, employee travel, fuel, communications, information technology, payment to municipalities, payment to WI school districts, payment to CESA, payment to state, payment to WTCS

400 Non-Capital Objects

Supplies, instructional media, paper, non-capital equipment, equipment components, textbooks and workbooks, non-instructional computer software

500 Capital Objects

Site components, site improvements, buildings and additions, capital equipment and vehicles, equipment rental

600 Debt Retirement

Principal and interest on long term notes, long term bonds, temporary notes, state trust fund loans, capital leases

700 Insurance and Judgments

District liability insurance, district property insurance, worker's compensation insurance, cost of judgments issued by courts or state or federal agencies, unemployment compensation

800 Transfers

Transfers to other funds (ie, to the special education fund from the general fund, to the food service fund from the general fund)

900 Other Objects

Revenue transits to other districts, CESAs, etc; dues and fees, cash balance adjustments, refunds of prior year revenues, property tax chargebacks, trust fund expenditures, unrealized loss on investments, other miscellaneous

Revenue Source Summary Codes – An account designation used to classify revenues and other sources of income according to their origins

100 Interfund Transfers

Operating transfers between funds, residual balance transfers between funds

200 Revenue from Local Sources

Property tax, non-capital resale, school activity income, school co-curricular admissions, interest on investments, gifts, fundraising, contributions, student fees, rentals, summer school revenue, student fines

300 Interdistrict Payments within Wisconsin

General base cost tuition - open enrollment or tuition waiver

400 Interdistrict Payments outside Wisconsin

Interdistrict payments for services

500 Revenue from Intermediate Educational Agency Sources

Federal aids transited through CESAs or intermediate sources, Medicaid transits from CESAs, other payments from CESAs or counties

600 Revenues from State Sources

State aids – general equalization aid and categorical aids, such as transportation state aid and library aid

700 Revenue from Federal Sources

Federal special project grants, ESEA Title program grants, federal aid received through the state agencies other than DPI

800 Other Financing Sources

Non-recurring sources of funds, including: land and other real property sales, long-term debt proceeds, long-term loans, state trust fund loans, long-term bonds, capital leases

900 Other Revenues

Adjustments, insurance dividends and reimbursements, debt premium and accrued interest on non-refinancing debt, refund of disbursement, refund of prior year expense including E-Rate refunds

REGULAR MEETING - BOARD OF EDUCATION SCHOOL DISTRICT OF SOMERSET

November 21, 2016

Board Vice President Marie Colbeth called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Colbeth shared that Gunther was absent. Those in attendance were Nancy Dressel, Brian Moulton, Marie Colbeth, Courtney Kurkowski, Katie Thurmes and Patty Schachtner.

Pledge of Allegiance: All present stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

District Mission: Developing learners. Empowering futures. Together.

District Vision: To become a premier community, bridging learners with their passions and pathways.

Statement of Core Strategies: Enhance Learning

- Advance services and operations 1.
- 2. Engage community through partnerships
- Cultivate professional growth and leadership 3.

Protocol Reminders: Board members are asked to follow the agreed upon protocol:

- 1. No side bar discussions
- No interruptions (including cell phones) 2.
- State your concern 3.
- 4. Ensure that you understand
- Don't take things personally 5.
- 6. Adhere to time limits
- Come prepared 7.
- 8. Ensure all are heard

Moulton moved with second by Dressel to approve the agenda with the addition of the approval of Youth Options being added to the agenda. As per request from Dressel, Youth Options will be added under Enhancing Learning for discussion and then to consent for approval. Motion passed unanimously.

Superintendent Reports: Fablab: High School Principal Chris Moore spoke of the collaboration with the community of a Fablab. Moore also spoke of the grant that has been applied for and the match the school would need to provide to accompany it.

Dr. Bezek shared an appreciation award he received for being a part of AASA and being on their Executive Committee.

Enrollment: As of November 7, 2016 enrollment is at 1,586.

Hiring: Bezek mentioned the hires that have been added since the last board meeting.

Strategic Plan Update: Bezek spoke of the Strategic Plan and that he would like to get the core team back together to update the plan. This will be added to future work sessions for further discussions.

Student/Staff Feedback Sessions: Student Council Rep, Shelly Schmitt, spoke of a session Dr. Bezek recently had with the seniors and shared the seniors liked knowing they had a voice and were being heard. The same process will take place in each of the buildings.

Student Council Report: Student Representative Shelly Schmitt recapped events and shared pictures of events occurring at the high school which included WITC Career Day, the Creative Writing Festival, the addition of Student of the Term at the high school, field trips the art students have recently attended, the student council holiday fundraiser and the winter sports and activities that have just started.

Positive Recognition: The board recognized 2016 State Cross Country Participant: Anya Swanson. Coach Abby Christensen spoke of Anya's amazing season.

The board recognized 2016 State Honors Choir Participants: Collin Gallo, Kayla Huerta and Jacob Wright. Vocal Musical Instructor Jaimie Palbicki explained the process of how the WMSA approval process works and shared how well the Somerset students did.

Palbicki shared details of a fundraiser she will be participating in at UWRF and also the musical which will be occurring at the high school in December.

The meeting was recessed at 7:40 p.m. and reconvened at 7:55p.m.

Open Forum: Colbeth explained the process of how the open forum will take place. No one came forward.

Enhancing Learning: Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment, Trish Sheridan provided handouts and a presentation on Understanding the State Report Card which also included the Spartan results as the embargo has been lifted and the information has now been made public. Bezek added that this topic could be added to a work session for further discussion. All schools either meet or exceed expectations and student achievement has gone up five points from last time. Student growth was discussed and questions from the board were addressed.

High School Principal Chris Moore explained the high school results and spoke of the Aspire and ACT scores. The High School SLO is for staff to help use active reading strategies and how this will be used to increase the number of students meeting or exceeding the college benchmarks on the ACT and ACT Aspire in the areas of Reading, English, Science and Math.

Middle School Principal Sara Eichten spoke of the middle school scores. The SLO for the middle school is to decrease the percentage of students performing at a below average level in math and reading to less than 10% while increasing the percentage of students performing at an above average level in math and reading to greater than 40%.

Elementary Principal Dr. Chris Kamrath explained the results as well as the SLO. The SLO focuses on student growth in ELA. The number of JK students below the benchmark will decrease from 75% to 20%. Kindergarten students below benchmark will decrease from 75% to 20%. First – fourth grades will decrease by 5% and increase by 5%. Kamrath answered questions from the board regarding the testing and assessments.

Bezek recapped that there were bright spots but there is work to do and explained how this ties in with the strategic plan.

Cultivating Professional Growth and Learning: Youth Options: Dressel asked how many applications there were this year compared to last year as well as the cost. Dressel also asked how many of the credits actually transfer on for the students after they graduate and attend college. Dressel would also like to see this item added to a work session for further discussion.

Colbeth moved with second by Schachtner to approve the Youth Options Applications for spring 2017. Motion passed unanimously.

Colbeth spoke of the new website and the discussions she was a part of at CESA regarding the website being accessible to those with special needs. Sheridan spoke of how CMS, the district web provider, has been challenged on this. The district team members that worked on the website will gather to walk through this.

Engage the Community through Partnerships: Thurmes spoke of an event at the New Richmond School that is on the topic of protecting student's digital footprints. Schachtner spoke of the offer the Jacob Wetterling

Foundation made to the district. Thurmes also spoke of upcoming events through the county that may be of interest to the Somerset district residents.

Advance Service and Operations: Nothing to report.

Consent Agenda: Thurmes moved with second by Schachtner to approve all consent items: Approve the Minutes of the Regular Session of October 24, 2016 as presented. Approve the Minutes of the Work Session of November 7, 2016 as presented. Approve October/November Board Bills. Motion passed unanimously

DRAFT WORK SESSION - BOARD OF EDUCATION SCHOOL DISTRICT OF SOMERSET December 5, 2016

Board President Bob Gunther called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Roll call was taken. Present were Bob Gunther, Nancy Dressel, Brian Moulton, Marie Colbeth, Patty Schachtner Katie Thurmes and Courtney Kurkowski.

Protocol Discussion: Dr. Bezek opened the conversation on protocol. There was no discussion from the board.

State Report Card: Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment; Trish Sheridan, opened the conversation on the State Report Card. Sheridan walked through the priority areas: Student Achievement, Student Growth, Closing Gaps and On-Track and Postsecondary Readiness. High School Principal Chris Moore spoke of the math program and explained Eureka Math. Sheridan reiterated that math has been a topic of conversation at the district for a few years as well as how the needs of all students in math can be met. Moore explained how other districts have seen some decline in their scores as well. Somerset is right on average with other schools in the area/conference. Moore also explained the implementation dip and how this occurs. The amount of class time spent on math at the high school, middle school and elementary were discussed. The amount of time spent on math and the impact of Eureka Math in correlation to results and what can be expected was talked through. The principals and Sheridan answered questions from the board. Schachtner spoke of how to involve parents and celebrate the wins the school does have. Bezek stressed that knowing where the strengths and weaknesses are is key to help plan and get the strategic plan in place.

Strategic Plan Update: Bezek spoke of revisiting the Strategic Plan including Mission, Vision and the Belief Statement. Bezek compared the Somerset Mission Statement, Vision and Belief Statements to that of his past district. There will be a committee to look at this and the work of the past team will be respected. The Strategic Objectives, which are the what of what you are going to do, were discussed. Somerset does not yet have Strategies, how these have been accomplished at past districts was talked through. Bezek also shared and explained Strategic Delimiters and how current practice or tradition should not be allowed to interfere with consideration of new ideas. A planning day for December 15, 2016 is in place to tweak and look as the current strategic plan. Bezek stressed the importance of honoring the work that was done this past summer while having the work wrapped up by May, 2017.

NEOLA: Bezek spoke of an upcoming visit with Stu Waller from NEOLA and how the guidelines will be discussed and policies walked through. Dressel asked about who maintains the records of the guidelines and what the reading process is for this.

France Trip: High School Principal Chris Moore spoke of a request he received from Miss Crawford regarding a trip to France she would like to help facilitate. Crawford spoke on the topic as well as the particulars of the trip. Crawford shared that she used to facilitate and accompany students and community members on these trips in the past. Teaching a community ed class to adults that would like to travel with the group is something Crawford would like explore also. The benefits to the students and community were shared as well as how a collaboration with other teachers could occur. Schachtner asked about the cost and how the opportunity could be made available to students that may not be able to afford it. Dressel asked if policies would have to be changed or updated. Discussion ensued on the topic. Gunther asked for something in writing for the board.

Youth Options: High School Principal Chris Moore stated the cost of Youth Options, in 2009-2010 the costs were approximately \$9-10K. Recently the costs per year for Youth Options range from \$32-39K. Moore explained the jump in costs and contributing factors including the scheduling changes and its impact. Schachtner asked what the minimum requirements for students is to get accepted. High School Counselor, Jenna Evenson explained the process and how the acceptances are made. The impact of College in the Schools on Youth Options was discussed. Schachtner asked if it was reason to get out of school or it is reason to learn and she wondered if we are really working on rigor and what are we doing to push the College in Schools. Moore spoke of the growth in the College in Schools and AP classes. Schachtner asked if we are causing more damage. Moore responded that the state mandates this and guidance can be given to students to encourage AP classes and College in Schools classes versus Youth Options. Schachtner explained how it is looked at from a tax payer perspective. Gunther shared that the students having the opportunity to get acclimated to the college setting was a plus. Dressel would like a comparison and percentages of the costs as well as then comparing this to the benchmark schools. Evenson spoke of how individualized the process is. Schachtner spoke of how this could be a

barrier for students that do not have transportation as well as if students have to sign a waiver as to riding with other students.

Course Offerings: High School Principal Chris Moore presented the draft 2017-18 High School Course Offering booklet to the board. How the needs of all students can be met and how courses can be set to meet these needs was explained. The course areas were talked about and math was a topic that the high school spent much time on. Preparing students for their careers and offering what they need and can benefit from is key. The changes/updates to Engineering, English, FACS, Math, Science and Technology Education courses were explained as well as the costs. Dressel asked about pacing and if Moore had spoken with other schools. The pacing was explained as well as the adjusted rigor for the students. Thurmes asked how these align with the strategic plan when we do not really have one yet. Moore responded that this is being addressed and looked at.

FABLAB: High School Principal Chris Moore shared how the Fablab would look and where it would be located at the high school. The equipment needed as well as current equipment was discussed and how the classes would all correlate. The schools that have Fablabs were talked about and how the Polycom system could be used to share the learning with students using other Fablabs. The cost of purchasing the equipment was shared and how this would be a collaborative effort. The benefits to the community and how the community could use the equipment was presented. A proposal was sent to SMC by the high school and the high school is waiting to hear back. Moore asked for the board to give the ok to submit a grant. Dressel stated that tech ed classes have taken a dip with the schedule change and how would this impact that. Moore explained the students could take the courses through community ed as well as other ways the students could benefit from this. Gunther asked if the application was put in for the grant, would the district have to accept it and be financially liable. Bezek suggested the board give the ok for grant to be submitted.

The next Work Session will be held on January 9, 2017.

Once around the table:

Dressel: Would like to see Benchmark Schools identified so relationships can be built and results looked at.

Moulton: The opportunity for a France trip is appreciated.

Gunther: The video recording is a positive and some minor tweaking can be made.

Kurkowski: Nothing to report.

Schachtner: Mentor meeting at the high school is this week.

Colbeth: excused herself early and was not present for once around the table.

Gunther adjourned the meeting at 7:54 p.m.
