# High School SLO

During the 2016-2017 school year, Somerset High School staff will help students use active reading strategies (e.g. highlighting, underlining, questioning, notes in margins, etc.) to increase the number of students meeting or exceeding the college benchmarks on the ACT and ACT Aspire in the areas of Reading, English, Science, and Mathematics.

### Middle School SLO

Over the course of the 2016-2017 school year, the middle school will decrease the percentage of students performing at a below average level in math and reading to less than 10% while increasing the percentage of students performing at an above average level in math and reading to greater than 40% on our Performance Series exam.



# Elementary School SLO

The elementary school SLO focuses on student growth in ELA.

The number of Junior Kindergarten students below benchmark will decrease from 75% to 20% as measured by the PALS Letter Sound Identification assessment by May 2017.

The number of Kindergarten students below benchmark will decrease from 75% to 20% as measured by the PALS Pointing assessment by May 2017.

The number of first through fourth grade students below grade level will decrease by 5% and the number of first through fourth grade students above grade level will increase by 5% as measured by Fountas and Pinnell benchmark assessment by May 2017.
