DRAFT REGULAR MEETING - BOARD OF EDUCATION SCHOOL DISTRICT OF SOMERSET February 16, 2015

Board Clerk Tammie Wishard called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Roll Call was taken. Present were board members Tom Walters, Marie Colbeth, Kelly Ott and Tammie Wishard. Absent were Brian Moulton, Mike Connor and Bob Gunther.

Ott moved, with second by Walters, to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Groups or Individuals Wishing To Be Heard: Wishard read off the rules for this portion of the meeting. Jill Hills, parent of elementary students, asked what the board communication policy is regarding the school board elections. Acting board president Wishard responded that the New Richmond News places candidate information in the paper and actual candidate information cannot be placed on the school district website. Superintendent Rosburg added that the website and Facebook are used to communicate the polling locations and other general voting information. Board Member Kelly Ott spoke of a forum with school board members that will be held on March 30, 2015 at the Somerset Public Library. Susie Kadlec, high school instructor shared that Carolyn Spoerl, high school instructor, and the students that are involved with the service learning projects are doing an excellent job with many hours of work put in and it is a good opportunity for the students.

Positive Recognition: The Board recognized 2015 Valedictorian, Susan Schmitt, daughter of John and Kathleen Schmitt. High School Principal Chris Moore stated that Susan is very active in numerous high school activities including; service learning projects, editor of the yearbook and countless hours of volunteer work at many organizations that are all grateful for her help. Susan has attended Badger State and her future plans are to attend UWRF. The board presented Susan with a certificate and congratulated her on her achievement.

The Board recognized 2015 Salutatorian, Lauren Sandy, daughter of Kenneth and Kristin Sandy. Principal Moore shared that Lauren is also very involved in school activities and that being involved equals being successful. Lauren has spent many hours volunteering with Habitat for Humanity, Feed my Starving Children and Ronald McDonald Cooks for Kids to name a few. Lauren is the recipient of a scholarship from Michigan Technological Institute and plans to attend school their after graduation. The board presented Lauren with a certificate and congratulated her on her achievement.

The Board recognized the Wisconsin Choral Directors Association 2015 State Convention Performers and Advisor, Mr. Perau. Mr. Perau explained the process in which school are chosen to participate and stated it is great honor to be chosen. The students all worked hard and rose to the challenge. Perau thanked Mr. Jason Erickson for volunteering to drive one of the instruments to the conventions which took place in Appleton, WI. Perau also thanked the Somerset Lions for donating the cost of tickets for the students to attend a concert that took place during the trip. Perau expressed his gratitude to Rachel Erickson, elementary and middle school instructor, for preparing the students in their early school years. The School board members presented each member with a certificate.

The Board recognized the 2015 State Danceline Participants and Coaches Hailley Leverty and Tara Montgomery. Sarah Colling spoke on behalf of the coaches and team and said the kickline finished 11th and this was their best year yet. Colling also shared that Gabbie Vogel received the highest all state dancer recognition by placing in the top seven soloists in the state. The board presented Colling with certificates for the dancers.

The meeting was recessed at 7:23 p.m. and reconvened at 7:48 p.m.in the learning center conference room.

Amy Arnold of RMM Solutions provided and IT Update. Arnold spoke of simplifying the network and doing due diligence to make sure servers are not in use before decommissioning. RMM has a VMWare expert, this engineer will look at the 51 servers the district has. The environment is complex, once the VMWare and servers have been gone through and reduced, the cost will go down as well. Wishard asked about Office 365. Arnold explained it is VM on servers and is in the cloud. Arnold stressed that RMM does not want to decommission a server and have it cause something to go down. Being discussed as a team is looking at Office 365 and Google for Education. Further discussion as a team will occur. BYOD versus One to One is being looked at as well, there is no exact or right

answer on this. Walters asked about the SAN servers and explained they are working well. One server did go down and the SAN server did what it was supposed to do.

Jeanne Germain and Kay Vater, Gifted and Talented Instructors, gave a presentation on the Gifted and Talented Program. Vater explained the PETS program which ties into the Badger test. Vater also explained the upcoming math test and the students that are preparing for it are very excited. Also upcoming is a trip to SMC and a presentation on site from 3M. Vater also spoke of a high school student that comes to the elementary school to work with a nine year old on physics. A high school student is also coming to the elementary school to work with the GT students on a book writing project. Vater described that visiting other schools and seeing their GT programs has been a great learning experience. Germain opened by saying she loves middle school students and looks forward to working with them. Her 5th and 6th grade math students are working on a project that entails starting a business. The 5th and 6th grade authors are writing mysteries that will be submitted to a contest. The older students are learning to code which is a free program offered from MIT. Germain is also prepping the eighth grade students for high school registration. The 7th and 8th grade reader s are participating in a free program at CESA. At the high school level, there are job shadowing opportunities as well as looking at additional opportunities for the high school students. Germain also spoke of a student doing a SLP possibly at ES to raise tolerant and compassionate students. Shannon Donnelly, Director of Pupil Services, shared they have exceeded all expectations and are doing a great job.

Ott moved, with second by Colbeth, to approve the Consent Agenda with change in the wording on item D. The word Resignation is to be changed to Retirement.

Motion Passed Unanimously with change in the wording on item D, the word Resignation being changed to Retirement.

Discussion:

Teaching and Learning Committee: Committee Chair Ott spoke of her attendance at the State Convention and shared wellness tips and gadgets that she brought back. Ott also spoke of the different sessions that each board member attended. Ott would like to see more health and wellness discussions take place. Walters spoke of one of the key note speakers and how engaging he was and how he was not afraid to try anything new. Involving community members, staff and all interested parties is the proper way to go about referendum planning. Ott also spoke of bullying issues that had been brought up at a prior meeting. Ott shared that bullying is being addressed, there has been an article in the New Richmond News. Ott also spoke of an open forum that can take place in which sharing and collaborating can occur. She would like a date to be set and asked staff that would be involved to set a date and start ball rolling. A parent asked about the diversity piece of it. Ott said that diversity would be a part of this as well. The parent then asked what would come of the group? Ott wants open dialogue so all can speak and stress their thoughts. Ott spoke of the policy that the board has in place and would like open dialogue to happen. Colbeth said it is about bringing awareness to the table. This will be addressed further at the Teaching and Learning committee which will take place the first Monday in March. Patty Schachtner asked if it would be easier to go through the youth survey which has already been completed by the students. Superintendent Rosburg stated this will be part of the process. Parent Jill Hills asked the parent that spoke of the diversity issue if anyone had followed up with her. Hills thought it was unsatisfactory that a month had gone by. Colbeth reiterated that the superintendent and principal had spoken to this parent on numerous occasions and dialogue is occurring. Ott stressed they want to work towards these situations occurring. Nancy Dressel shared that she would like to see the youth risk survey results so that parents can be more involved.

Information: Superintendent Rosburg stated student enrollment is 1,598 which is up a bit from last year at this time. The date of the upcoming committee meetings is March 2, 2015. Rosburg also spoke of the erroneous Infinite Campus message that was sent out inadvertently today. IT determined that Somerset, KY should have been the district to receive this. Rosburg spoke on behalf of absent Dave Gerberding, Director of Business Services and Operations, on how the deficit came to be what it is. Rosburg briefly walked through the pieces of it and stated it would be shared and made public on Tuesday. There are still variables that are being looked at at the Government level. The variables that bring the deficit to \$780K are being looked at by the school district. Rosburg spoke of meetings in which all staff were invited to attend in which they could share budget ideas. Response was good and many ideas were shared via the meetings, emails and individual meetings with Rosburg. Early retirement, classroom budgets, fewer bus routes are all topics that were brought up. Rosburg will craft a letter and send to WI state government to ask legislators to make decisions that will be good for all students. This letter will be sent to all staff as well.

The board members in attendance will check their schedules to determine when they can attend.

Board Report: CESA 11 Update: Walters spoke of the CESA service contract as well as the budget for the state and how it will impact schools. Walters would like cost savings to be looked at in light of the Governor's budget proposal. Community and School Involvement: Walters spoke of four teams that are going to state from Robotics and as a cost savings they will be sharing a bus with Menomonie. The Somerset team did well and showed excellent sportsmanship. Ott thanked SMC for their sponsorship and Kraus Anderson for donation the competition box. Walters thanked Eric and Becky Olson for their many hours and hard work. Wishard thanked the New Richmond News for the write up in the paper. Ott spoke of the community input meetings and the recurring comments that have been expressed were that parents want more communications and want to be involved in decisions prior to them being made. Colbeth shared a big challenge with this is getting the information out to parents, particularly those that are not in attendance at the meetings. Walters spoke of Boarddocs and how it could help with this. Wishard shared that the schools that use it love it and it makes things easier but there is a cost to it. Ott shared that parents think the website is difficult to use. She would like to see parents share more specifics in what can be corrected.

WASB Convention Report & Recap: Will be brought back at the March meeting due to Moulton being absent.

Student Council Report: Student Council Representative John Siggens shared that the student council has been very busy and productive. Student Council has been planning the Polar Daze Celebration. It is taking place this week, February 16-20. There are many events being planned including dress up days, talent show and other fun activities. The juniors are working on prom planning. The seniors are working on their senior video and college preparations. Course registration is under way and the spring play is in full practice mode to be ready for the March performance. Winter athletics are wrapping up regular season play.

Directors' and Principals' Report: Eichten spoke of the middle school play that is this weekend. Much learning for staff has happened this month in regards to Badger testing. Staff have been preparing students for this test and prepping them for the stamina that is needed for this rigorous testing. Moore spoke of ACT and WCKE testing that the juniors will be taking and how to make a good testing environment. Ninth and tenth grade students will be attending colleges on testing day and seniors will be volunteering at Feed my Starving Children. Ott and Colbeth asked of the cost of these trips and would it make more financial sense to send the students that are testing off site? Trish Sheridan, Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment, shared what other districts in the area are doing and that Baldwin is only school in area that will not have school on testing day. Wishard shared that this is a good opportunity for students to be able to visit colleges. Sheridan also added that the district is preparing for the new battery of tests. The focus has been getting the engagement and thought to be that this type of thinking needs to take place every day, not just on test day. Also discussed was the Professional Development Day on February 6 which offered numerous opportunities for staff. Thirty staff members attended a speaking event by Rick Wormelli that took place in Menomonie. Mr. Wormelli's presentation was engaging and provided much information.

Action

Teaching and Learning Committee: Ott moved, with second by Colbeth to Approve Laude System. Ott shared that a parent spoke with her about this and was worried about tradition. Moore shared that he had spoken to this parent as well. To recap, they are looking at ways to include and recognize more students in the graduation ceremony. The purpose of the Laude System is to recognize students for the rigor of their academic program as well as their successes in that program. The Laude System will be initiated with the class of 2018. Motion passed unanimously.

Governance Committee: Ott moved, with second by Wishard, to Approve NEOLA Final Draft Policies. Walters would like the board to wait until all are in attendance. Ott wants to move forward as those that are absent have been part of past discussions. Motion passed with three yes votes and one no vote by Walters.

Ott moved, with second by Wishard, to approve the Adoption of NEOLA Policy Resolution. Superintendent Rosburg explained the resolution and that the board needs to decide on the date to be included on the resolution. April 1, 2015 is the effective date as decided by the board. Motion passed with three yes votes and one no vote by Walters.

Ott moved, with second by Walters to adjourn at 9:16 p.m.

Employee Assistance Program Fee for Service Contract

This Agreement entered into by and between FamilyMeans, whose address is 1875 Northwestern Avenue South, Stillwater, Minnesota, 55082 and Somerset School District whose address is 625 Sunrise Drive, P. O. Box 100, Somerset, Wisconsin, 54025.

The contact person for FamilyMeans is Pat Lockyear, Psy.D, LP, Employee Assistance Program Coordinator and the contact person for Somerset School District is Randy Rosburg, District Administrator.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Agreement shall be to establish and maintain an employee assistance program for the employees of Somerset School District. Said services shall be made available for mental health assessment and treatment for individuals, couples and families, financial counseling, concerns surrounding the elderly and referral for drug and alcohol abuse or addiction. The provision of services shall be for the purpose of, and hence, designed to provide assistance to the employees of Somerset School District and their immediate family members.

INDEMNIFICATION

Somerset School District agrees to indemnify and hold FamilyMeans harmless for any liabilities, claims, judgments, damages or costs, including reasonable attorneys' fees, asserted or awarded against or incurred by FamilyMeans, its directors, officers or employees as a result of any act of omission of Somerset School District. FamilyMeans shall notify Somerset School District of any written claims or demands made against FamilyMeans for which Somerset School District is liable under this section.

FamilyMeans agrees to indemnify and hold Somerset School District harmless for any liabilities, claims, judgments, damages or costs, including reasonable attorneys' fees, asserted or awarded against or incurred by Somerset School District, its directors, officers, or employees as a result of any act or omission of FamilyMeans. Somerset School District

shall notify FamilyMeans of any written claims or demands made against Somerset School District for which FamilyMeans might be liable under this section.

TIME PERIOD

This Agreement is for the period of one year beginning March 15, 2015, ending March 14, 2016; however, either party may terminate this Agreement with 30 days advanced written notice to the other party.

SERVICES TO BE RENDERED

In exchange for the fee described below, FamilyMeans agrees to provide services by and on behalf of Somerset School District to employees referred to its attention for assistance sessions.

BASIC SERVICES

FamilyMeans agrees to provide the following services/materials:

- Management Training: One, 60 minute session on mutually agreed upon topic.
- Employee Training: Up to two, 30 minute sessions on mutually agreed upon topic.
- Telephone or in-person consultation with Administrators/Managers/Supervisors to assist them in utilizing the EAP regarding employee problems.
- Annual renewal letter mailed by the Somerset School District explaining the benefits of the EAP to employees/family members.
- Promotional materials, i.e., brochures, information cards.
- Utilization reports provided quarterly or as deemed appropriate based on utilization of services.
- Satisfaction reports provided annually.
- One EAP newsletter for each employee to be distributed on a quarterly basis.
- Annual site visit.
- Courtesy referrals for one free, legal consultation per employee per year. Referrals for confidential legal consultations are provided to established local law firms in Stillwater, Minnesota and River Falls, Wisconsin based on the employee's state of residence. Legal consultations are not provided in matters wherein interests of the employee and employer are adverse or may be adverse. Any fees for legal services or consulting after the initial consultation are subject to agreement between the employee and the legal provider.
- Counseling services addressing employees' personal and work-related problems.

The employer agrees to:

- Notify the Employee Assistance Program Manager of any complaints on services being offered, and cooperate in the investigation and resolution of these complaints.
- Disburse newsletters and other promotional materials on the program.
- Provide information on the company's health insurance plan so appropriate referrals can be made.
- Schedule training sessions on an as needed basis.

FEES

Somerset School District agrees to pay FamilyMeans an administrative fee of \$275.00 per quarter to equal the sum of \$1,100.00 annually. Somerset School District also agrees to pay \$80.00 for each session for each employee in any given year, with a maximum of two (2) sessions per problem episode meeting insurance coverage criteria or three (3) sessions per problem not eligible for insurance coverage. Sessions are for assessment and referral of Somerset School District employees, board members and their family members. Based on a utilization rate of 3% and 220 employees, you may estimate the expected cost of the contract at \$2,156.00. Fee for assessments and/or any optional services purchased will be billed by FamilyMeans and paid for by Somerset School District at the end of every quarter throughout the contract year.

Employees will be informed when making their initial intake appointment that failing to attend an appointment without prior cancellation will result in the subtraction of one EAP session. Somerset School District will be charged the per-session fee for the failed appointment. To insure confidentiality, FamilyMeans will keep track of sessions available to individual employees.

MODIFICATION OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement may only be modified in writing by mutual consent of the parties. If unusual circumstances require a high rate of usage, Somerset School District and FamilyMeans will renegotiate the terms of this contract. Any modification of this Agreement must be signed by both parties in the same manner as the original Agreement.

INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR STATUS

For all intents and purposes under this Agreement, FamilyMeans shall act as an independent contractor and neither means, mode nor method of performance hereunder shall be subject to control of Somerset School District. FamilyMeans acknowledges that it

provides the same or similar services at large to third parties. FamilyMeans, its employees, agents and officers shall have no right or expectation to any compensation, salaries, wages, fringe benefits or other remuneration for the services provided hereunder except as described under the paragraph entitled Fees. FamilyMeans shall be responsible to provide its own office space, equipment, materials and supplies so as to fulfill its responsibilities to Somerset School District under this Agreement and, additionally, it shall carry such unemployment compensation and workers' compensation coverage as may be required of it under law.

AVAILABILITY BASIS AGREEMENT

It is the understanding of FamilyMeans that it shall make available its services under this Agreement to and on behalf of Somerset School District; however, Somerset School District shall not be compelled to make any minimal number of referrals on an annual basis during the term of this Agreement, nor shall it be responsible to pay to FamilyMeans any retainer or minimal fee in exchange for FamilyMeans making its services available on an as needed basis under the terms of this Agreement.

Student Council wrapped up a busy month. The high school had a successful polar daze week that was wrapped up with a Talent Show the last hour of the day on February 20th. We had a great group of talents and the students really enjoyed it.

Winter sports have wrapped up as well with two state qualifiers in wrestling and good final games by both the girls and boys basketball teams. Hockey lost their second round game at Hudson.

Course registration is very close to complete for all students. They have been completing it during their homerooms.

The spring play performance is right around the corner and coming along nicely.

Seniors have been having meetings regularly to get graduation plans underway including their class picnic, flower, class song, etc.

All Juniors completed the ACT the first week of March. They were served a breakfast by the staff and then took the ACT. The following day they took the WorkKeys, a career readiness assessment. Freshmen and sophomores did college visits and the seniors went to Feed My Starving Children. All in all, it was a busy couple of days but everything went pretty well.

District Goal: To Improve Student Achievement and Growth March, 2014-15

Use data from common assessments to measure student learning for achievement and growth on state and national standards

- Our curriculum work is now viewable to our public through links to our online tool Build Your Own Curriculum. The links are located both from the Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment website page and also on the Parent website page. This information is being shared through principal, department and teacher communications to our families. (Strategy 2: Action Plan A, Steps 5-9)
- The ACT and ACT WorkKeys were administered the first week of March to all juniors. The planning for this event started last year and was labor intensive for our staff especially our high school counselors. We have received positive feedback from all stakeholders. (Strategy 2: Action Plan E)

Evaluate and refine the Response to Intervention (RTI) models for K-12

• Trish and Shannon met with principals, school psychologists, and counselors at the building level to have a systematic discussion regarding what is going well with RTI in each building and what might need to be tweaked to best meet the needs of our students. (Strategy 2: Action Plan D, Step 7)

Create Life and Career Skills Opportunities to be implemented in 2015-2016

• In accordance with the strategic plan (*Strategy 1, Action Plan B*), the district is beginning to create a stronger partnership with colleges and universities to help students gain certifications that will directly align with future careers. A partnership between WITC and conference schools is being created to allow up to two of our students the opportunity to gain the first two welding certifications over the course of their 12th grade year. This will provide them the certification to be immediately able to apply for positions in the welding field upon their graduation.

Clarify and share progress and planning regarding the implementation of the 2011-2016 Strategic Plan

- Arrangements are being made to provide training and resources to expand our advanced placements offerings and articulated courses. Courses added for the 2015-16 school year include:
 - AP Psychology
 - AP Macro and Micro Economics
 - o AP Art (Strategy 2: Action Plan E, Step 2)
- Exciting News! We will be offering our first College in the Schools courses on campus partnering with the University of Minnesota. Dennis Potter will be teaching 2 semester long courses, HIST 1307: Authority and Rebellion: American History to 1865 and HIST 1308: Global America: US History since 1865 to replace our AP US History course. Students will be able to automatically earn 3 university credits upon successfully completing each course (6 university credits for the year). Dennis will be paired up with a university professor and our students will have an opportunity to participate in a field day on campus with college students. (Strategy 2: Action Plan E, Step 2)

Educator Effectiveness

• An Effectiveness Project Support Seminar was held after school on March 19. Questions clarified included the completion of the documentation log and professional reflections against the standard.

Other News from our Schools

District News

• Work continues to build our District Balanced Scorecard. Building leadership teams will be helping to

- define our indicators in the area of professional practice. The high school began this work, the other buildings will be discussing this portion of the scorecard in the near future.
- Somerset School District is hosting a free event for families called "Positive Solutions". This workshop is designed to provide parents with young children (ages 0-6) methods and strategies to promote positive behaviors. The sessions will teach parents how to foster their child's social emotional growth as well. The workshops run from 5:30-7:30 pm on March 16, 23rd, 30th, and April 13th, 20th and take place at the Somerset School District Learning Center. I look forward to reporting out on the success of this event at its conclusion.
- The District Emergency Management Steering Committee met on February 16th to discuss a wide variety of emergency management topics. This committee will meet again at the end of the school year as well.
- The counselors, school psychologists, and Shannon met on February 26th to begin developing a Crisis handbook to better guide staff in how to handle a crisis situation in our District such as an accident or death. We look forward to sharing this handbook with the Board upon finalization.

Elementary School

- Sherry Neisius is the staff member of the month for March. She was nominated by a peer for being flexible, easy going and willing to help whenever needed.
- Our school participated in a week long celebration of Dr. Seuss's birthday from February 23rd to March 2nd. The week featured daily trivia contests, a themed door decorating contest and a drop everything and read event on March 2nd.
- Our building sent 6 staff to Tiffany Creek Elementary School in Boyceville as part of a grant funded program to learn from schools who are excelling on Thursday, March 5th. We focused our learning on literacy instruction, interventions, RTI process and a behavior initiative known as PBIS.
- In addition to going live with BYOC on March 2nd, the Elementary School also went live on the same day with behavior reports through Infinite Campus. Parents are now able to access all of their children's behavior reports through the Infinite Campus parent portal.
- Our building had 95% of parents attend parent-teacher conferences in February.

Middle School

- Our March staff member of the month is Ryan Herink. He was nominated for volunteering to build the set for our middle school drama.
- The afternoon of Friday, March 6 was our blanket project. As a middle school we made 158 blankets to donate to TurningPoint Women's Shelter, Grace Place, Lakeview Hospital, and Avery's Blanket of LOVE Ministry. These blankets make a huge difference in the lives of children who are in unfortunate circumstances or dealing with major medical needs.
- We filled our Golden Ticket board just before spring break and students received a popcorn reward after our blanket parade to reward them for their great academic work and behavior choices!

High School

- On March 3, all 11th grade students took the ACT. We had great attendance for this assessment (only 8 students absent for testing). The 12th grade students volunteered at Feed My Starving Children and were able to prepare enough meals to feed 72 individuals for 1 year. The 9th and 10th grade students visited colleges and universities to help them begin their post-secondary planning.
- On March 4, all 11th grade students took the ACT WorkKeys. Again, we had great attendance for this assessment (only 8 students absent for the testing). All other students went to see the movie Selma and learn more about racial rights.
- Thank you to Katie Francis and Sarah Colling for all their work in preparing the students and staff for the ACT and ACT WorkKeys. The days went off flawlessly. Also, thank you to Jen Sutton for seeking donations for the 11th grade breakfast prior to the ACT. Additionally, thank you to all the staff, board members, and parents who arrived early to make the breakfast for the 11th grade students.
