Registration

Registration will be done this year with two nights of sign-ups. These will be held in the commons of the Middle School on Tuesday, May 9th and Wednesday, May 10th from 6:00 – 8:00 P.M. There is a registration worksheet (this is not a registration form) on the last page of the Summer School Booklet. Student numbers in classes will be limited and a class will fill on a first come, first serve basis. The grade requirement for registration is for the grade just completed. If your child is transported by bus, or if you wish them to attend all four hours of the day and it doesn't appear that a class is offered in their age category, special arrangements may be made.

The beginning grid in the booklet, listing all classes, may be helpful in filling out your worksheet. All classes are listed by weeks offered and the number following the class gives the page number where the class information may be found in the booklet. Please look for age appropriate classes.
