Participation in Technology Education Courses

REWARDS-- The grade that you earn in this course is your reward or pay for your contribution to the projects and activities, but self-satisfaction and realization that its work that YOU did should be a bigger reward..... Don't just work for a grade! You don't work...the consequence are you don't get paid (you won't pass the class....... **F**)

RESPONSIBILITIES-- *If* you are gone and miss a class period you are responsible to make up the work. You need to make the arrangements with Mr. Barron to get this made up, especially the safety demonstrations and tests. All missed demonstrations will be made up before or after school. It is the responsibility of each student to get there assignments finished on the proper due dates.
