### **Registration Location: Somerset Senior High School (Multi-Purpose Room)**

Anyone interested in hunting and/or recreational shooting is welcome to enroll in a certified Wisconsin Hunter Safety Course to be held at the Somerset Middle School, with Registration & Orientation held at the Senior High School in the Multi-Purpose Room.

Anyone born on or after Jan. 1, 1973, must complete a Hunter Safety Course in order to purchase any hunting license in Wisconsin. Hunter Safety graduates will receive a certificate that is accepted in every State, Canadian Province and Mexico.

All volunteers are Department of Natural Resources Bureau of Law Enforcement Division certified Wisconsin Hunter Safety Instructors. Each Instructor has had a complete criminal history and background check.

#### **REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

- Registration by phone or on-line is not offered for this course. Registration is in person only and on a "first in line, first registered" basis on registration night only.
- Registration begins at 6:30 p.m. It is suggested to arrive a little earlier to get into line. Orientation begins at 7:00 p.m.
- A parent is required to attend registration with any minor student in order to sign the required enrollment forms.
- A parent is also required to attend the entire orientation with a child under age 18.
- Class size is limited.
- Complete cost for this course is \$10.00
- There is no age restriction for anyone wanting to enroll however, please note that the course materials and examinations are written at a sixth (6<sup>th</sup>) grade reading and comprehension level.
- DO NOT bring a firearm to registration & orientation night or to any class nights. Students will need firearms for Field Day ONLY.
- Special needs students are welcome to enroll however, a parent must contact the Lead Instructor at least two weeks prior to the course starting date, in order to make a request for any special accommodations that will be needed for the student.

#### **COURSE INFORMATION**

- This course is 19 hours long and runs for 3 weeks.
- Classes are every Tuesday and Thursday evening from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. The last week of class will have an additional class night, which will be held on a Monday evening from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. (see page 2 for more information).
- Field Day is held on a Saturday (see page 2 for information) from 12:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. A parent or legal guardian must accompany any minor student for the entire Field Day activities.
- Students must provide their own .22 rifle for Field Day activities.
