IMPORTANT: <u>Parents who need to pay by check/cash will need to come to the middle school between 5 p.m. and 8 p.m. on April 30 for assistance – online registration checkout is by credit card only.</u>

Things to know about registration:

- Registration worksheets are in the back of the booklet (these are not registration forms). Please use the
 worksheets to organize class choices (and alternate choices) for each hour of the day for each week this is a
 useful tool during online registration.
- Class sizes are limited and will fill on a first come, first served basis some classes fill up quickly preparing ahead of time is helpful. This year you will be put on a wait list for your first choice and an email will be sent asking you to sign up for another class. To reduce the frustrations from last year, you will be able to go in and JUST register for the one extra course. A staff member will contact you if your first choice becomes available.
- The grade requirement for registration is for the **grade just completed**.
- Please look for age-appropriate classes. If parents have problems finding appropriate classes to fill all four hours
 due to age/grade limitations, special arrangements may be considered please visit with a staff member during


