If your child is attending summer school, the information below may be useful to you!

- Summer School Starts Monday, June 11th and runs through July 20th
- Please send your child's schedule with them for the first few days of school so that they know where they are going. Here is a link on how to find that.
- Doors open each day at the middle school at 7:50 a.m.

TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION:

- Bus information was sent home to families in the mail or in backpacks
- In case you have misplaced the letter, bus information is also available through the Infinite Campus Portal
 - o Please make sure to choose SUMMER SCHOOL at the top in the drop-down menu
 - Routes have had a few changes since the times have been published due to additional students signing up or after-school-care needs changing
 - AM ROUTES: please have your student outside waiting for the bus at least 10 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE PUBLISHED TIME – at least for the first few days, until established
 - PM ROUTES: please allow some time from the published time for your student to arrive home at least for the first few days
 - The first couple of days can be a bit chaotic helping the younger students find their correct bus, and our staff is there to help them, but they are few compared to the many students, so it can take some time to get the buses off campus until kids know their routine.
 - School Age Care students will shuttle from the elementary to the middle school in the morning, and back to S.A.C. after school on RT1.
- ANY ADDITIONS OR CHANGES TO FOR BUS TRANSPORTATION CAN BE IMPLEMENTED <u>AFTER THE FIRST WEEK</u>
 <u>OF SUMMER SCHOOL</u> TO ALLOW TEACHERS, STUDENTS, FAMILIES, AND DRIVERS TO ESTABLISH CONSISTENCY
 WITH THE ROUTES.
- Reminder: Because summer school is elective, and we are able to offer such flexibility with the schedules, not all students ride the bus each day, or attend summer school each week, so bus routes continue to be fluid in their stop times by a few minutes please be prepared to allow some flexibility of time for pickup and drop off. In most cases, this will not be more than 5-10 minutes we just want you to be aware of this.
