This is an elective course open to any 9th through 12th grader. It is a one term course lasting for a 85 minute period which is worth 1/2 credit.

The course is designed to provide the students with basic information needed to understand, and use the proper tools and equipment to do some repairs and maintenance of your present or future home. You will also learn when repairs should be handled by a professional. Having knowledge of repairs and what is needed will also enable you to determine if your repair man is providing you with a good service at a good price or ripping you off. This course may also provide students with some possible career paths and ideas for exploration of careers during your remaining high school courses or even post-secondary education.

Students will be working in teams, with partners and as individuals on some projects, according to how each student learns best, or what the best approach is for the whole class.

Safety will be expected and demanded at all times. A pair of <u>regulation safety</u> <u>glasses</u> with side shields will be required for<u>all</u> shop and lab work. It is the responsibility of each student to provide their own pair of safety glasses; Mr. Barron will give you safety glasses if you need them. Power tools and equipment may be used, therefore the proper SAFETY PROGRAM PLAN requirements must be met and followed. Because of the nature of the class a \$15 fee is charged to help cover the costs of the materials used for the activities that are selected.
